Community Pancake Breakfast Trivia

- The first community pancake breakfast at Maple Grove was held in March of 2010.
- Approximately 25 people showed up for the very first breakfast.
- During the first year we served breakfast from 8am till 10am. One year later, in March of 2011 the hours changed to 7:00am to 9:30am.
- The number of diners jumped to 88 in March of 2011 and then to 100 in April of 2011.
- Sometime later we started serving at 6:30 and the number of people coming continued to grow.
- In the first year we averaged 35 people served, and the second year the number more than doubled to 85. In the third year it jumped to 159.
- The highest average attendance was 177 which occurred in 2014.
- The last three years of the event averaged between 166 and 172.
- The total number of people served through the seven years was 10,604.
- Assuming the average person ate 3 pancakes at the breakfast, the total number of pancakes eaten comes close to 32,000!
- The highest number of people served in one day was 221 in June of 2016, when Herb went to Detroit on a Maple Grove MDS trip. ☺

Statements that can be made as an act of risk

- 1. Statements that acknowledge hurt or concern
- 2. Statements of desire to be restored.
- 3. Statements of apology or confession
- 4. Statements acknowledging the good intentions of the other.
- 5. Statements of what one would do differently if one had a second chance.

Sunday:

Sunday School in auditorium at 9:30 AM - "Why have you Forsaken me?" Inner healing, dealing with guilt, anger, abuse, low self-esteem, failure, and the struggle to trust God. (Psalm 22:1-11; 2 Cor. 12:1-10)

Worship Service at 10:30 AM— "Stand up and Walk". My encounter with death, life and whole-being recovery through bypass heart surgery in 2016. All healing comes from God whether through "faith healing" or through medical arts. (Psalm 30:1-5; John 5:1-9; James 5:14-15)

Evening Service at 7:00 – "We Heal when we Forgive". Anger and bitterness may be appropriate responses when we are wronged, but it is destructive to our own bodies and souls to stay there. (1 Sam. 24; John 20:19-22)

Monday Evening at 7:00

"Wounded by the Faith Community". We who care deeply about faith and about the church feel the wounds of church conflict most deeply. (2 Cor. 1:3-11)

Tuesday Evening at 7:00

"For the Healing of the Nations". Our witness as global citizens brings together evangelism and peacemaking. (Isaiah 2: 2-5: Revelation 22:1-6; 16-17)
