


Welcome to Maple Grove Mennonite Church

Answer to Last Week's Question: The opportunity to officially organize a Ladies' sewing presented itself in the person of Frances Zook, a Mifflin County native and Chicago mission worker soon to marry Daniel Oyer and move to Michigan. She presented Chicago mission needs to our women in 1909 and "sewing circles" have existed continuously since that time. Beginning in 1942 minutes were kept and in 1950 the sewing circle became a part of the national church organization, named Women's Missionary and Service Auxiliary, later changed to Women's Missionary and Service Commission.
