Leadership is a topic that's widely talked about but largely misunderstood. Chris Tatom will be leading a 9-week **Sunday School elective** starting on March 17 on the topic of leadership. During this 9 week class, we will be looking at leadership qualities of David, Paul, and, of course, Jesus. These 3 biblical leaders set tremendous examples of what great leaders are supposed to look like. Leadership comes down to influence and not authority. Therefore, if you have a family, friends, or are around people at work, you are a leader and this elective is for you! Chris will also break down the spiritual gifting of leadership and what Paul means in Romans 12:8. Sign-up in your Sunday School class by Feb. 17, if you are interested in diving deeper into what the Bible says about leadership and biblical examples of what a leader is supposed to look like.

This will be followed by conversations with those individuals. Our desire would be to find two people (for both elder/deaconess) who would be willing to serve. If our discernment reveals two people willing to serve, we will use the lot to determine who God is choosing for this ministry. The first few Sundays in February will be **different types of sermons** than we normally have. On February 3, we will be having an "interview sermon". Jared Byler will be interviewing John Baker, Alan Kauffman and Chris Tatom on "Hearing God." At the end of the interview, there will be opportunity for questions from the congregation. So come prepared to ask questions you may have regarding hearing God. Then, February 10 and 17, Alan will be talking about "How to Study the Bible." These two sermons will grow out of his study/preparation for the January 21st evening he led

at Allensville Mennonite as part of the Spiritual Disciplines course there by pastors/lay leaders from the area.

What if I told you that together we could reach the low-income neighborhoods of Lewistown with the Gospel of Jesus Christ? What if I told you that a family from your church, or a Sunday School class, or an older couple, or some of your youth could establish a spiritual presence in a low-income neighborhood of 25 homes, that through that presence they could love, evangelize, and disciple the people of that neighborhood in the Gospel, that they

could sit on a blanket with the kids of the neighborhood each week and share the Gospel, and that they could deliver the Word of God to the adults each week in their homes? What if I told you that this would cost about \$15.00 per week and it would take about one hour a week?

All of this is possible right now, all we need is to equip Christians to come and join us in the work. Backyard Ministries has developed discipling relationships with 100 Lewistown families. But there is so much more to do. Each week when I come to Lewistown I drive and walk by neighborhoods and doors that could be reached. I visit as many families as I can a day, but there are hundreds more that I do not have the time to visit. Our ministry is willing to share the methods that God has given us with you. We want to equip you and your congregation to adopt a neighborhood. We have taken the time to map out neighborhoods in Lewistown for you to adopt. We will provide everything you need.

I have attached a flyer for our training seminar at Mountain View Mennonite Chapel on Tuesday, January 29 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Our plan is to train Christians to take the Gospel to Lewistown through door ministry and Backyard Clubs. We will provide everything needed and be giving opportunity for folks to adopt neighborhoods. I would love to see each of your churches adopt at least one neighborhood. This is actually very possible. If the dozen or so churches who are receiving this letter do this, we could see an amazing move of God in the low-income neighborhoods of Lewistown this year. Thanks so much for your support and God bless you in your work for the Kingdom today.
