Preparation for Anointing Service next Sunday

Next Sunday, at the conclusion of the worship service, there will be a time for anointing for anybody who would like to participate. Some of us may have grown up in traditions where anointing is only a “last rites” act for people near death. Or we may sometimes think of anointing being only for people with physical illnesses. While both of these are proper moments for anointing; God desires that people be whole physically, emotionally and spiritually, since any “dis-ease” in one area can affect other areas. God’s healing comes in many forms and persons receiving anointing do so as a way of committing themselves and their situation to the Lord and receiving what the Lord has to offer them. You only need to have faith that God CAN heal you; not that God WILL heal you. Whether or not you receive the healing you desire is not a critique of your faith. God loves you; God cares for you; God is with you in your struggles. The act of requesting anointing is a sign of trust and faith in God.

Here is what you can expect if you choose to participate next Sunday, whether it be to request forgiveness for sin; a physical illness; an emotional struggle (whatever healing you desire in your life). When you come forward, Alan Kauffman will privately ask

you if you want to briefly describe why it is you are requesting anointing; he will ask you if it is your heart’s desire to place your life in God’s hands, willing to receive the healing and life God has to offer; he will then anoint you and offer you a blessing.
