Our **Maundy Thursday Service** will be held this coming Thursday evening, March 28 at 6:30 PM in the fellowship hall. There will be a light evening meal, communion and hand or foot washing. Following the meal and communion, all will be invited to participate in a few different stations around the fellowship hall. At the first station, chalk will be used to mark our hands or feet, representing the sins we continue to struggle with. At the second station (hand or foot washing) we will wash the chalk away. These stations will help us explore our ongoing struggle with sin, and in response, speak Christ's forgiveness, cleansing, and life to each other. There will also be an alms offering collected.

An **Easter Breakfast** will be served in the fellowship hall on Easter morning at 9:00. Sign-up sheets are in the SS classrooms and on the bulletin board to sign up to bring breakfast casseroles or baked French toast, pastries and fruit. If you are not able to sign up, just bring one of the above food items. Place settings will be provided. There will be no Sunday School that morning and the Worship Service will begin at 10:00 AM. All are welcome!
