This weekend, the SS class that meets in the old sewing room spent the weekend together and focused on strengthening their marriages. They used a video from Right Now Media to aide in their discussion: 4 Lies that (almost) wrecked our marriage with JD & Veronica Greer. For the next four weeks, the lies that were presented in the video will be shared in the bulletin, followed by the truth and some questions to consider in your own marriages. You are encouraged to have these discussions with your spouse, and you can check out the video if you are interested in hearing more.

Lie #1- I married the wrong person.

The truth is: You always marry the wrong person. This is true because you married a sinful person and sinful people always disappoint.

The truth is: You are actually married to several people over the lifetime of a marriage. We all change and grow.

The truth is: What you are looking for in your spouse is really what you should be looking for in God.

The truth is: If you are looking to your spouse to fulfill the role that only God is capable of fulfilling, they will be the wrong person.

Challenge: Confess to each other if you have been expecting your spouse to fulfill the role that only God can fill.
